Pre-release sneak: theremin virtuoso's new album





You'd be forgiven if the prospect of listening to a rare new instrument makes you cringe. Especially so if the instrument in question is an electronic one invented early last century, with a sound most commonly associated with cheesy low-budget science fection flicks. The album also contains a catchily funky cover of the Beach Boys' Good Vibrations. But some of the slower, less dense tracks, like Last Dair (which was previously released on Valentine's Day as a free download), give Shueh-il more space to show off the theremin's expressive potential. Shueh-il was the first musicians to perform Last Date - written by Ployd Cramer - on a theremin last November (2008), and she thinks of the Intest version as Xing Path's love authem.

"The theremin is put through phase distortion and played staccato-like (minimal portamento with slight pitch bend) for that bolder, electro-pop feel without it being incongruous with the sheen of the almost smooth jazz/electronics feel of my version," says Shueh-li, explaining her approach to timbre and performace on Last Date.
